

Illness and Vaccine/Immunization Policy

The YBC board strongly recommends the use of vaccines/immunizations. However, we respect the right to not be vaccinated, or not have your child vaccinated. Therefore, no camper will be refused admission to the camp even if they have not been vaccinated. The YBC does retain the right to quarantine and/or send a camper home based on medical determination if an illness is present as this is a public health issue and not an individual rights one. This also includes staff members.

Reportable illnesses to the county health nurse and state include those covered by vaccines, including measles, whooping cough, hepatitis, and meningitis. If sent home there will be no refund.

Illnesses not covered by vaccines such as strep throat, colds, viral gastroenteritis and others may also require quarantine and/or sending home. These will be given a partial refund if requested.

If a child/minor is ill, parents will be notified immediately and discussion between the parent and camp medical personnel will ensue. Clinical symptoms and signs will determine the course of action unless the person is to be sent home. If urgent/emergent treatment is indicated, the person would be taken to the Livingston Urgent care/Emergency room.
